PRESCHOOL REGISTRATION, WITHDRAWAL & CANCELLATION POLICY FORM

A full JCCGV Family Membership or Single Parent Membership (Complimentary Memberships are not applicable) must be current for Priority Registration and remain current for the full school year in order to receive Members' rates.

All registrants for ECE programs are required, at registration, to make a deposit to secure a space for their child in the program (see below). **This deposit is NON-REFUNDABLE, and will be applied to the last payment if the account is current.** If the program is full, you will be placed on a waitlist and your deposit will not be processed.

SHALOM ALEPH AND SHABBAT SHALOM

The payment schedule will be as follows:

Upon registering - **\$200** non-refundable deposit for Shalom Aleph; **\$100** non-refundable deposit for Shabbat Shalom; **\$250** non-refundable deposit for both Shalom Aleph & Shabbat Shalom (when registering at the same time)

1 st Payment	August	1/3 of remaining rate
2 nd Payment	September	1/3 of remaining rate
3 rd Payment	October	1/3 of remaining rate

SHALOM BET

The payment schedule will be as follows:

Upon Registering - **\$250** non-refundable deposit

1 st Payment	August 25
2 nd Payment	September 25
3 rd Payment	October 25
4 th Payment	November 25
5 th Payment	December 25
6 th Payment	January 25
7 th Payment	February 25

If payment is made in full at the time of the first installment date, a 3% discount will be given on the total amount.

If a parent registers 2 children or more simultaneously for the ECE preschool programs, a 5% discount will be given on lower enrollment fees.

Payment arrangements must be in place by June 12, 2010. Otherwise, the preschool space and deposit will be forfeited.

Late Registration:

If a parent registers a child after September 1st, the payment schedule will be as follows: Upon registering, 2 month fee and \$200/\$250 deposit is required.

By December 31st up to - 3 installments (for 2 year old programs)
up to - 5 installments (for 3 and 4 year old program)

Deposit/Cancellation/Withdrawal Policies:

If you cancel, the \$100/\$200/\$250 deposit is **not refundable or transferable** to other programs or persons. In the event that parents wish to withdraw their child from the program, **60 days written or emailed notice is required, by the 1st of any given month. There will be no ‘pro-rates’**. Only after receiving the written or emailed notice will the JCCGV refund any remaining funds, which will be calculated from the end of the 60-day notice period. **All funds will be forfeited if withdrawal is after March 1st of the current school year.**

Age requirement:

Shalom Aleph & Shabbat Shalom - children must be 2 years old by December 31st of the current school year.

Shalom Bet - children must be 3 or 4 years old by December 31st of the current school year.

General Information:

Maximum enrollment for Shalom Aleph and Shabbat Shalom programs is 12 children per class. Maximum enrollment for Shalom Bet program is 22 children per class.

The gender composition for each class will be taken into consideration and the Director, in this regard, will make the final decision.

All children for the 3 and 4 year old program should be toilet trained or in the process of toilet training upon commencement of class.

The JCCGV has the right to cancel programs with insufficient registration.
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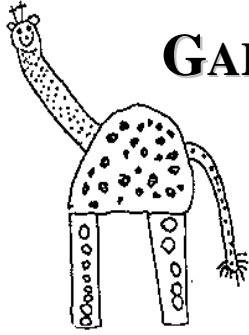
Some registration situations will be at the Director’s discretion.

When to Expect Confirmation of Acceptance

Please ensure that you have carefully read, completed and signed the Application and Registration/Withdrawal Forms. Both documents must be handed in at registration time in order for us to process your application.

8 February: You will receive confirmation of acceptance in the program and your deposit will be processed. If the program is full, you will be notified and placed on the wait list. Please ensure that you inform us of any contact information changes.

16 July: An Information Package will be mailed out, including required forms to be completed, a School Closure Calendar and the Fee Schedule.

25 August: First fee installment payment is due and your cheque or credit card will be processed. Please ensure that you have a payment plan in place by June 12.

Your careful attention to reading all material in the Information Package is much appreciated. Licensing requires that all necessary documents must be complete and handed in to your teacher before you leave your child with us in September. Please bring the completed documents that you receive in your Information Package to the Parent Orientation meeting in early September.

Licensed Early Childhood Education at the Jewish Community Centre of Greater Vancouver

“Play is the most complete educational process of the mind, and is nature’s magic device for ensuring that each individual becomes self-educated. Play may be described as a spontaneous, creative, desired research activity carried out for its own sake. It is motivated by innate curiosity and enquiry. It is the expression of children’s urge to find out and discover for themselves how to live, how to be.” Neville Scaarfe, University of British Columbia

What makes early childhood education at the JCC unique?

All of the programs at the Karen and Gary Simkin Child Development Centre share the same philosophy of learning through play with a strong emphasis on children’s social and emotional growth. Our teachers are licensed early childhood educators who continue to upgrade their knowledge and skills with regular professional development opportunities. Whether it’s a morning preschool room or a full-day daycare room, the same rigour is present around curriculum development. Teachers in each room nurture and provide care and education for your children, building relationships of trust and security. We believe that your children’s growing capacity for kindness and compassion, creativity and critical thinking skills are the foundation for our future.

We begin with your children’s interests as a way to build curriculum. When the curriculum reflects your child’s interests and ideas they feel a sense of belonging and empowerment. Their potential for learning is greatly heightened. Inspired by the schools in Reggio Emilia, Italy and now an integral part of the new Early Learning Framework from the British Columbia Ministry of Education, this philosophy of early learning is based on the image of the child as competent, curious and capable. Pictures, photographs and text in each room tell stories about what children are learning during their day.

Our multi-aged groupings invite children to move through their day based on their interests and abilities. We believe that not all children learn in the same way. Not all children are interested in the same thing, at the same time. Whether its free play, group time, snack or outdoor play, children get the individual care and attention that they need to flourish.

Your children are introduced to the richness of Jewish traditions and values. Holidays are celebrated through stories, songs, art, games and of course cooking. Hebrew is integrated into our daily schedule. We come together as a community each Friday for Shabbat in the Atrium of the JCC with family and friends. Visits to Louis Brier Senior's Centre and L'Chaim Adult Daycare are highlights of our intergenerational programming.

The arts are used as a language for learning and self-expression. Children express their thoughts, feelings and ideas about the world through drawing, painting, collage and sculpture. Dressing up and pretending, constructing new worlds with blocks and puppet play are just a few of the many ways that children are encouraged to imagine.

Academic subjects are introduced in a hands-on, age appropriate way. In science, children explore and experiment, in math they sort and classify, in English they tell, write and illustrate their own stories. Literacy is an essential part of our early learning environments and each room is rich in books for different ages, abilities and interests. The alphabet and early reading skills are introduced through play.

Whether its time in the gym, dance studio, or on the playground, children challenge themselves physically each day.

It's all at the JCC! Visits to the Sidney & Gertrude Zack Art Gallery, The Jewish Museum and the Isaac Waldman Library enrich and expand learning. Early childhood specialists in science, dance, theatre and music join us during class time.

We are participants in the *Seeds of Empathy*, a national project promoting social and emotional competence by teaching young children about infant development, diversity and respecting and valuing others.

Our teachers have studied *Ethical Start*, a curriculum for children, parents and teachers based on the ancient Jewish text, *Pirkei Avot*, teachings of the fathers.

Preschool Programs

Shalom Aleph

2 year olds (2 days)

Mo & We 9:00 – 10:30am or 11am – 12:30pm

Tu & Th 9:00 – 10:30am or 11am – 12:30pm

Shabbat Shalom

2 year olds (1day)

Fri 9:00 – 10:30am or 11am – 12:30 pm

These programs are specially designed for two-year-olds and may be your child's first experience in an early childhood environment. Maximum enrollment is 12 children with two teachers and one parent volunteer to assist. Shalom Aleph and Shabbat Shalom classes may be combined for a 3 day week.

Shalom Bet

3 & 4 year olds (5 days)

Mo-Fr 9:00 – 11:30 am

Children in this 3-4 multi-aged group spend their mornings in small groups based on their interests. Free play, group time, snack, outdoor play or specially scheduled sessions for art, Hebrew, music and sports offer children opportunities to flourish in this early childhood environment. Maximum enrollment is 22 children with three teachers. After school enrichment opportunities include lunch bunch, art, sport ball, soccer and yoga.

The JCC is open to everyone and is part of a network of over 250 Jewish Community Centres in Canada and the USA. Our mission is to provide leadership in culture, recreational, educational and social activities enabling individuals and families to achieve and enhance a positive identification with Jewish Life and Israel and to develop good citizenship and a sense of community.
